





## The Book Fair is coming!



We are excited to announce that LMS will host an in-person book fair this year! The week of November 9-13 the book fair will be set-up in the library. Book Fair will look different this year than it has in the past, but we know it will be a fun week!

LMS will be following recommended guidelines to make sure that this is a safe week for your child as they shop for new books. Here are a few of the steps we are taking to ensure safety in the library:

1. Your child will shop during his/her library time. A schedule will be provided the week before the book fair so you know when your child comes to library.
2. There will be no before or after school shopping.
3. There will be no parent volunteers this year.
4. No parents or guests may shop the in-person book fair. A link for our virtual fair will be sent home.
5. The fair will be sanitized between each class.
6. Send all money in a baggie marked with your child's name. We can accept cash and checks made out to LMS. We will also accept Scholastic's virtual e-wallet option. Information to set that up for your child will be sent home.
7. Remember that Wednesday, 11/11/20, will be a virtual day for HCS. The book fair will be closed that day.
